

ASD SSG meeting N°26

held on the 21st and 22nd of March 2016 at GIFAS, Paris

Executive Summary

The SSG contribution to ASD activities has increased, including an updated reporting line from SSG to the ASD Services Commission and an increased recognition of ASD role in regards to standards governance.

The progress of the several on-going standardisation projects supported by SSG has been reviewed, including AP242 ed2, AP239 ed3, STEP new architecture, ILS suite of specifications, JT, MoSSEC.

Several updates of the SSG website were discussed, implementation of which should be effective in the next weeks.

In the next months, SSG intends to:

- Further identify and specify interoperability requirements from the industry.
- Develop a roadmap on STEP standards, to be shared and validated with AIA.
- Propose an organisation allowing Implementer Forums (CAX-IF and PDM-IF) to cover an increased variety of use cases and interoperability standards (e.g. adding system requirement exchange as a new segment of the PDM-IF).
